

## ~ Noah ~

### The Hall of Faith ~ Hebrews 11

*“Looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith...” Hebrews 12:2*

Because the study of Noah is so rich and full of many lessons, we will break down the study of Noah’s incredible faith into three parts: **Before the Flood**, **During the Flood** and **After the Flood**.

#### **Before the Flood**

1. Read **Hebrews 11:7**, **Genesis 5:28-6:22**, **Matthew 24:36-39**, and **2 Peter 2:5**.  
From the Scriptures above, what was the condition of the world and its people before the flood?
2. From **Genesis 6:1-22** and **Hebrews 11:7**, to what work did God call Noah?
3. How do you think Noah was able to undertake such an enormous task?

4. **Hebrews 11:7** tells us that Noah “moved with godly fear”. What does it mean to be *moved with godly fear*?

5. Has the Lord called you to step out in faith but you are afraid? What can you glean from the following promises to help you take such a step of faith?
