The Hall of Faith ~ Hebrews 11

*"Looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith..." Hebrews 12:2*

1. Read **Hebrews 11:23-29**. Also read **Exodus 1 & 2** along with **Acts 7:17-36** for background on Moses' life.
  
2. In **Exodus 1**, Pharaoh ordered the Hebrew midwives to kill all newborn baby boys which the midwives refused to do. In **Hebrews 11:23** it tells us, "**By faith** Moses, when he was born, was hidden three months by his parents". At what price were Moses' parents willing to walk by faith?

*"By faith Moses' parents hid him for three months. This must mean that they received some revelation that he was a child of destiny, because faith must be based on some revealed word of God."*

**13.** Review **Exodus 3**. Briefly explain what happened.

**14.** How did God encourage Moses in **Exodus 3 & 4** that he was not alone in this calling?

**15.** When God calls us to step out in faith, it can be scary. How do the following Scriptures encourage you to trust the Lord?

**16.** God did many signs and wonders in preparing His people to leave Egypt. The last sign was the death of the firstborn and the institution of Passover. Review **Exodus 11 & 12**. By faith Moses kept the Passover. Why did it require faith for him to do so?

**17.** If you can, compare the first Passover with the significance of the cross of Calvary. Explain why we need to receive Christ by faith.

- 18.** “By faith they passed through the Red Sea as by dry land” (*Hebrews 11:29*). Review **Exodus 13:17-14:31**. What are the benefits of stepping out in faith in obedience to the Lord at His word, regardless of what it looks like?
- 19.** Moses was called by God to lead His people, and by faith Moses did so in obedience. Each step of the way the Lord taught Moses faith. As Moses led by faith, the people followed by faith. Think about your own life of faith and how it can affect your children, your spouse, your family, and others. Write down your thoughts and the fruit and blessings you see.
